CBD rubbish and recycling collections

City traffic, limited footpath space and lots of pedestrians mean wheelie bins aren't suitable for Auckland's inner CBD. Instead, there's a special bag collection for rubbish and recycling.

Auckland Council's inner CBD kerbside rubbish and recycling collection covers Karangahape Road, Queen Street and the area bounded by Mayoral Drive, Albert Street, Britomart Place and Quay St. On Emily Place, collections are on the north side only.



How inner CBD rubbish and recycling bags work

- Council delivers official orange rubbish bags and clear recycling bags to inner CBD properties twice a year, in February and August.
- Check with your landlord or body corporate if you haven't received your bags.
- These bags are paid for through your rates.

If you run out of council bags, you can buy more at the Auckland Council Service Centre at 24 Wellesley St, Auckland Central, or go to aucklandcouncil.govt.nz to find another retailer.

What goes in rubbish and recycling bags?

Read the front of your bags carefully for information about what can and can't go in. For more information on recycling please use the recycling search tool available at aucklandcouncil.govt.nz.

Please don't put cardboard in either bag. Instead, bundle flattened cardboard securely and put it out next to your rubbish and recycling bags.

Please fold down any pieces of cardboard longer than 1m.



Place bags/cardboard kerbside, neatly and not blocking the footpath, business entrances or litter bins.

When to put your rubbish and recycling out

There are restricted times of day that inner CBD rubbish and recycling can be put out. Please make sure you place your bags and cardboard kerbside, neatly and not blocking the footpath, business entrances or litter bins, during the following times:

Illegal Dumping

- Rubbish/recycling that isn't put out in an official council bag is considered illegal dumping.
- You can be fined up to \$400 for illegal dumping. Body corporates can be fined up to \$30,000.
- You can also be prosecuted for placing rubbish/recycling at the kerbside outside of collection times.

If you see illegal dumping in your area, please report it to council on 09 301 01 01.
